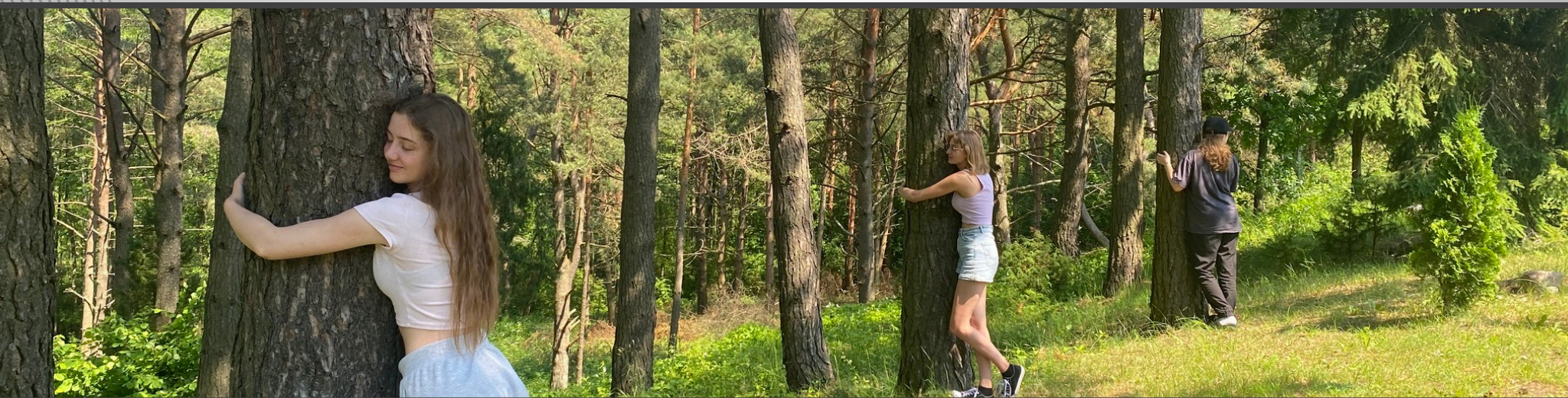

## EXPANDING YOUTH WORK PRACTICES FROM LITHUANIA TO LOCAL COMMUNITIES

The Erasmus+ study visit “Youth work in Lithuania” offers participants a unique opportunity to explore how youth centers, public schools, NGOs and Policy makers in Lithuania work together to support youth.

You'll visit various organizations, see their daily routines, and learn how they combine formal and non-formal education methods.



This visit focuses on getting to know the people and places, experiencing the local culture, and understanding how different approaches come together to make a positive impact.

- **See it in action:** Visit Open Youth Centers in both cities (Vilnius) and towns (Trakai) to see different ways of working with youth.
- **Mix school and youth work:** See how schools and youth organizations work together by visiting places like the Lentvaris Gymnasium.
- **Learn the "Lithuanian Model":** Understand how Lithuania's youth policy and national standards help support NEET & young people with fewer opportunities.
- **Borrow great ideas:** Find specific Lithuanian tools and Good practices that you can adapt and use in your own country.
- **Build a team:** Meet other youth leaders and NGOs to start long-term projects together through Erasmus+.



# WHO CAN PARTICIPATE?

## 3 participants per country

- **Youth Workers & Leaders:** Actively engaged in daily activities with young people.
- **NGO Representatives:** Decision-makers or project managers capable of implementing new organizational strategies.
- **Youth Space Coordinators:** Individuals managing physical locations for youth development.
- **Youth Mentors:** Professionals focused on the individual growth and guidance of young people.
- **Commitment:** Ready to actively participate in all 5 days and lead a follow-up activity in their home country.





# PROGRAMME FLOW

## Program of the study visit:

**Arrival day** - introduction and informal time of getting to knowing each other

**Day 1:** Exploring youth centers and different forms of organising open youth centers

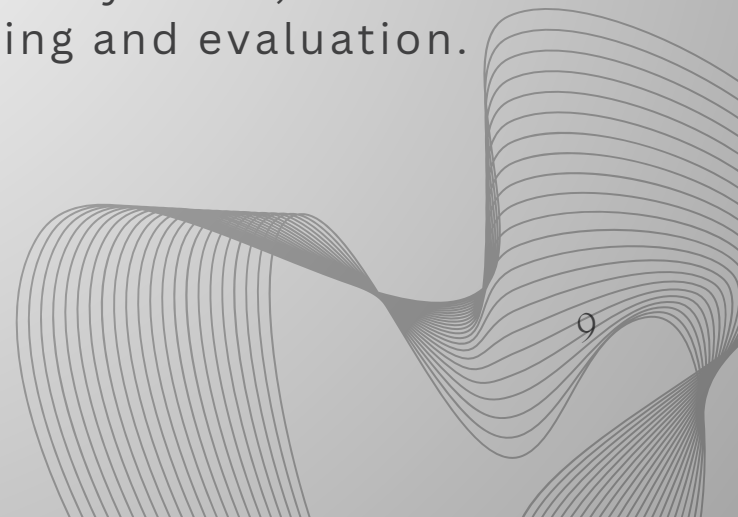
**Day 2:** Exploring formal education institutions: where formal meets non- formal

# HOW TO ARRIVE?

- You can fly to Vilnius or Kaunas (the largest cities in Lithuania).
- We encourage the greenest travel option possible. If feasible, please come by bus or train.
- A group pick-up from the Vilnius city centre will be organised on the evening of the arrival day. Exact time will be confirmed after tickets are purchased.
- Travel between the city and the project venue will be organised by the organisers. The costs for this trip will be covered from your travel budget.

- Bank payment copy for the tickets or receipt if you paid by cash



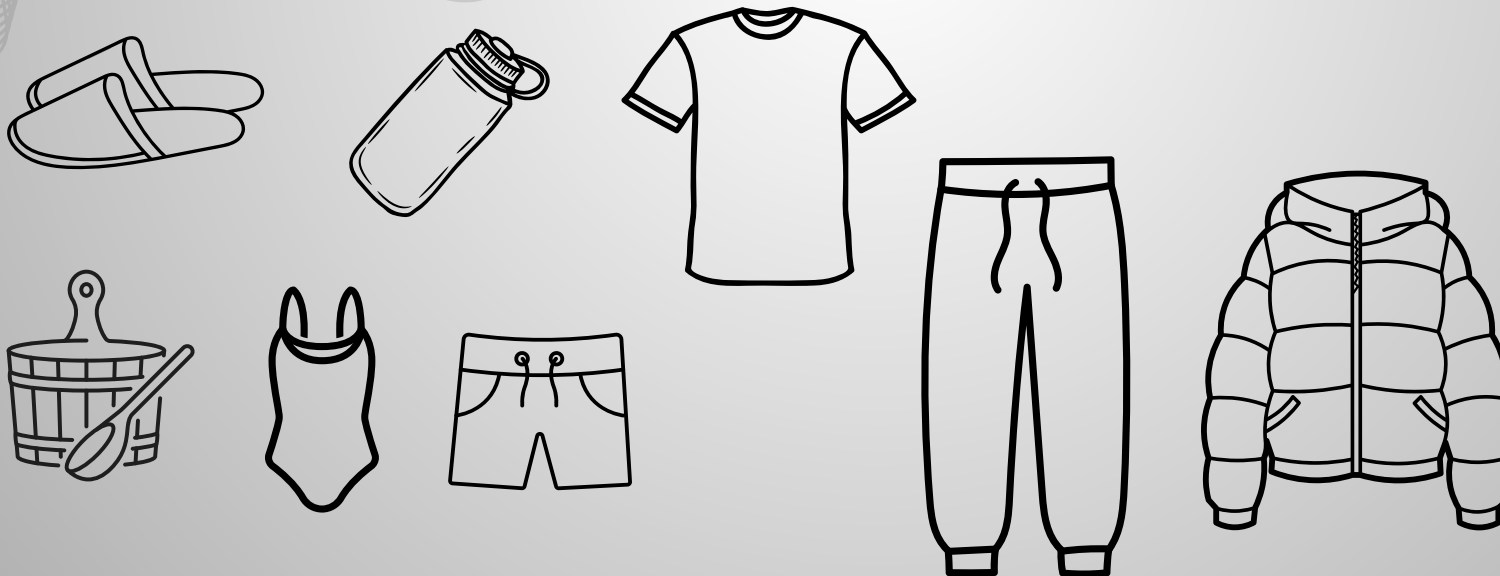
